

Section 1-5 Policy on Non-Discrimination and Affirmative Action.

It is the policy of the University of Hawai'i to provide equity of opportunity in higher education, both in the educational mission and as an employer. The University is committed to comply with all State and Federal Statutes, rules, and regulations which prohibit discrimination. The University is committed to a policy of nondiscrimination on the basis of race, sex, age, religion, color, national origin, ancestry, handicap, marital status, arrest and court record, sexual orientation, or veteran status. This policy covers admission and access to and participation, treatment, and employment in the University's programs and activities. Sexual harassment is prohibited under this policy. The University shall promote a full realization of equal opportunity through a positive, continuing program of nondiscrimination and affirmative action (41 CFR 1-6 Chapter 60) on each campus.
