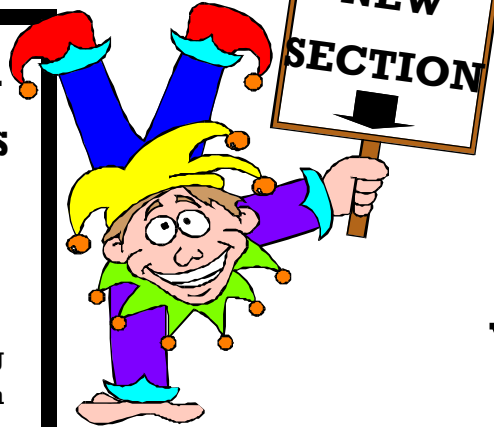

## WEEKEND TRIPS

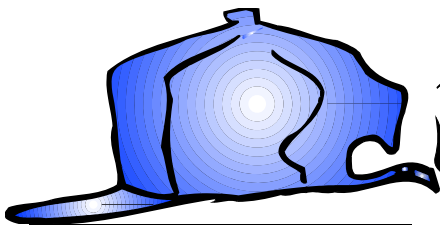
