Bike/Moped Registration

Housing residents will be required to register their bikes at the Resident Life

Office in Ikena. Registration should be completed by the end of the first week in the semester. Bikes obtained during the semester should be registered within five days.

Registrations helps identify bikes that have been abandoned so that they can be removed to make more space available. Having the serial number will help identify your bike from others, and in the case of theft, provide needed information to security, bike shops, and the police.

-Bicycles not registered will be considered abandoned, and removed

-Removed bicycles will be destroyed or donated to charity
