Participate in pre-checkout with your CC

* Your CC will come to your room the week before finals to review the process with you and check your keys.

Schedule a checkout

* Appointments are mandatory – Plan 48 hours ahead of the time
* Be flexible- Remember that your CC has about 50 residents and finals too

Clean your Home

* Your entire area must be cleaned the furniture back in the original location

Be Ready

* All of your items must be packed and out of your unit at the time of check out.

Dates:

- * **You must check out prior to Saturday, May 16th by 8:30am**
- * Graduating seniors may check out by noon on graduation day.
- * Residents taking the first semester summer classes must be ready to move from their hall space to their Ikena space on Saturday, May 16th. We will notify you when your space is ready for you.
- * To request an extended stay, you must fill out a formal request by Thursday, May 14th. You may pick up the request form at the housing office (PB-11). Requests to stay beyond Sunday night will not be granted. Requests will only be granted for extreme circumstances. You may be required to move into temporary housing during your extended stay.

Need a break from all that studying? Want a quick pick-me up? We will be keeping Kauanoë Lounge open Sunday through Wednesday night of Finals Week (May 10-13th) for Study Breaks. 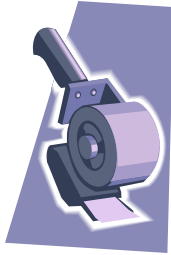
Application for Graduation Deadline

Planning to graduate in Summer or Fall 2009? If so, you must submit a graduation application. The priority deadline is April 1. Meeting the priority deadline ensures that you will receive a preliminary graduation evaluation prior to the close of registration of the term in which you intend to graduate. The final deadline to submit an application for summer graduation is June 19, and the final deadline for Fall 2009 graduation is September 11.
